MSU's precollege programs offer students opportunities to explore their intellectual capacity, discover a range of future possibilities, learn more about their culture, and develop a better understanding of others. - [Broad Summer High School Scholars Program](#)
Residential program designed to assist in preparing Detroit Public High School students for college attendance and nurture an interest in a career in education.
- [Detroit Area Pre-College Engineering Program](#)
This program provides instructional and practical application activities for students in Detroit-area schools during a three-week summer residential program.
- [GEAR UP/College Day Program](#)
The federally funded GEAR UP/College Day Program provides low-income and underrepresented students who currently are in 7th grade with the services that help them to be admitted, retained, and to graduate from postsecondary institutions.
- [Michigan 4-H China Project](#)
A global education program that often uses the arts for in-school and after-school learning experiences targeting K-6 students.
- [MSU Arts and Culture Youth Programs](#)
A list of extensive MSU programs and links, both domestic and international, offered to children and youth that encompass arts, theatre, humanities and culture, music, dance, multimedia, film, and design.
- [MSU High School Equivalency Program](#)
This secondary education program offers individuals with migrant or seasonal farm work backgrounds a unique opportunity to obtain a General Educational Development certificate.
- [OsteoCHAMPS](#)
This program aims to increase the number of disadvantaged high school students in Michigan who select osteopathic medicine as their profession of choice. The program works

with high school juniors and seniors in select communities to motivate and educate them about health professions, particularly osteopathic medicine.

- [Striving Toward A Reachable Target](#)

This program was established by osteopathic medical students, faculty, and staff in partnership with Lansing Eastern High School (LEHS) to teach study skills and offer training and personal mentoring to students at LEHS.

- [Upward Bound](#)

The Upward Bound Program motivates talented students from low-income families to complete high school and enter a post-secondary educational institution.
